**ORDER AUTHORIZING REJECTION PROCEDURES FOR CONTRACTS OR  
UNEXPIRED LEASES OF NONRESIDENTIAL PROPERTY  
PURSUANT TO SECTION 365(a) OF THE BANKRUPTCY CODE**

Upon the Emergency Motion for Order Authorizing Rejection Procedures for Contracts or Unexpired Leases of Nonresidential Property Pursuant to Section 365(a) of the Bankruptcy Code (the "Motion") filed by the debtors and debtors in possession, (collectively, the "Debtors"), and the Court having jurisdiction to consider the Motion, having heard the evidence and statements of counsel regarding the Motion, and finding that no further notice be is needed, it is therefore

**ORDERED**, that the relief requested in the Motion is GRANTED; and it is further

**ORDERED**, that all capitalized terms not defined herein shall have the meaning given to them in the Motion; and it is further

**ORDERED**, that the Debtors are authorized to reject any of the Contracts by providing notice to the affected party, which rejection shall become effective (a) the seventh business day following the date on which the Debtors provide written notice of the rejection to the affected party and the parties on the Master Service List (the “Effective Date of Rejection”), substantially in the form annexed to the Motion as Exhibit A; and (b) in the event that there is an objection filed prior to the expiration of the seven (7) day notice period, such date that is determined by this Court; and it is further

**ORDERED**, that any proof of claim for damages arising from the rejection of any of the Contracts must be filed on or before thirty (30) days after the Effective Date of Rejection for each Contract or the bar date set by the Court, whichever is later; and it is further

**ORDERED**, that the provisions of Bankruptcy Rule 6004(g) staying the effectiveness of this Order for 10 days are hereby waived, and this order shall be effective immediately upon entry thereof; and it is further

**ORDERED**, that this Order shall be binding upon the Debtors, all creditors of the Debtors, and any trustee appointed in this proceeding or any trustee appointed in any subsequent proceeding under Chapter 7 or Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code; and it is further

**ORDERED**, that the Debtors, their officers, employees and agents, are authorized to take or refrain from taking such acts as are necessary and appropriate to implement and effectuate the relief granted herein; and it is further

**ORDERED**, that this Court shall retain jurisdiction over all matters arising from or related to the interpretation and implementation of this Order.
