The following is a brief recitation of George Hesterberg's claim. On 9/23/2018, George Hesterberg was a patron at the Gold's Gym located at 5520-A Randolph Road, Rockville, MD (Wintergreen Plaza location). While using the sauna, Mr. Hesterberg was rendered unconscious due to the negligence of Gold's Gym and/or it's agents and/or employees. At the time of this incident neither the timer for the sauna nor the thermostat to set the temperature of the sauna were operable. He suffered severe burns which required extensive medical treatment, is likely to require future medical treatment, and left him severely scarred. Mr. Hesterberg is seeking all available damages under Maryland law for his injuries including but not limited to both past and future medical bills, pain, suffering, inconvenience, and damages related to scarring.
