INSTRUCTIONS FOR PROOF OF CLAIM FORM

The instructions and definitions below are general explanations of the law. In certain circumstances, such as bankruptcy cases not filed voluntarily by the debtor, there may be exceptions to these general rules.

Items to be completed in Proof of Claim form**Court, Name of Debtor, and Case Number:**

DEFINITIONS**Debtor**

A debtor is the person, corporation, or other entity that has filed a bankruptcy case.

Creditor

A creditor is a person, corporation, or other entity owed a debt by the debtor that arose on or before the date of the bankruptcy filing. See 11 U.S.C. §101 (10)

Claim

A claim is the creditor's right to receive payment on a debt owed by the debtor that arose on the date of the bankruptcy filing. See 11 U.S.C. §101 (5). A claim may be secured or unsecured.

Proof of Claim

A proof of claim is a form used by the creditor to indicate the amount of the debt owed by the debtor on the date of the bankruptcy filing. The creditor must file the form with the clerk of the same bankruptcy court in which the bankruptcy case was filed.

Secured Claim Under 11 U.S.C. §506(a)

A secured claim is one backed by a lien on property of the debtor. The claim is secured so long as the creditor has the right to be paid from the property prior to other creditors. The amount of the secured claim cannot exceed the value of the property. Any amount owed to the creditor in excess of the value of the property is an unsecured claim. Examples of liens on property include a mortgage on real estate or a security interest in a car.

A lien may be voluntarily granted by a debtor or may be obtained through a court proceeding. In some states, a court judgment is a lien. A claim also may be secured if the creditor owes the debtor money (has a right to setoff).

Unsecured Claim

An unsecured claim is one that does not meet the requirements of a secured claim. A claim may be partly unsecured if the amount of the claim exceeds the value of the property on which the creditor has a lien.

Claim Entitled to Priority Under 11 U.S.C. §507(a)

Priority claims are certain categories of unsecured claims that are paid from the available money or property in a bankruptcy case before other unsecured claims.

Redacted

A document has been redacted when the person filing it has masked, edited out, or otherwise deleted, certain information. A creditor should redact and use only the last four digits of any social-security, individual's tax-identification, or financial-account number, all but the initials of a minor's name and only the year of any person's date of birth.

Evidence of Perfection

Evidence of perfection may include a mortgage, lien, certificate of title, financing statement, or other document showing that the lien has been filed or recorded.

INFORMATION**Acknowledgment of Filing of Claim**

To receive acknowledgment of your filing, you may either enclose a stamped self-addressed envelope and a copy of this proof of claim or you may access the court's PACER system (www.pacer.psc.uscourts.gov) for a small fee to view your filed proof of claim.

Offers to Purchase a Claim

Certain entities are in the business of purchasing claims for an amount less than the face value of the claims. One or more of these entities may contact the creditor and offer to purchase the claim. Some of the written communications from these entities may easily be confused with official court documentation or communications from the debtor. These entities do not represent the bankruptcy court or the debtor. The creditor has no obligation to sell its claim. However, if the creditor decides to sell its claim, any transfer of such claim is subject to FRBP 3001(e), any applicable provisions of the Bankruptcy Code (11 U.S.C. § 101 *et seq.*), and any applicable orders of the bankruptcy court.

Dear Angela Moore, MD,

This letter is to further update you regarding the Graceway Chapter 11 Bankruptcy cases, specifically including your outstanding honorarium payment.

As of today, Graceway has sent Evince only a small portion of the money that Graceway owes to its speakers – to you – but has refused to send the additional amounts owed. Moreover, although we have set aside the small funds that they have sent to us, we cannot yet distribute those funds to you because Graceway still may demand that Evince return those funds. Specifically, under the Bankruptcy Code, Graceway has the right to demand the return of all funds that were paid by or on behalf of Graceway up to 90 days before its Bankruptcy filing, which could potentially include the small amount of honoraria funds that we are holding. Although Graceway can make this demand immediately, it has up to two years to make such a demand. We believe that we have good defenses to any such demand, and have asked Graceway to make the remaining payments and to agree that it will not demand a return of prior payments, but Graceway has so far refused. As a result, we cannot yet distribute any monies owed to you by Graceway.

For the avoidance of doubt, let me reiterate that these funds, to the extent that we have them, have been set aside for your benefit, and such funds are not in any way “profits” or revenue of Evince. Evince has worked in the area of professional education and communications within the dermatology field for the last decade; and we plan to continue our efforts throughout the next decade and beyond. We greatly value our fine reputation and the solid relationships we have built with opinion leaders such as you over the years; maintaining these key relationships is crucial to the success of our business. We would never, therefore, purposely jeopardize our reputation by attempting to profit from an unfortunate situation, such as Graceway’s demise.

Please be assured that we are doing everything we can to get your money from Graceway, and that we will distribute money to you as soon as possible.

Note that at 11:30am EST on Wednesday, November 9, 2011 we will be holding a teleconference to answer any questions that you might have about the current situation as it pertains to Evince.

During the call, Evince’s counsel will be present and available to answer any questions you may have about the Graceway Bankruptcy Case.

We recognize that this is a difficult and delicate situation and we sincerely appreciate your patience as the wheels of justice slowly turn. It is our hope that all parties will be made whole at the conclusion of this case and that we can continue to work together to improve the future of dermatology practice and patient health.

**NOTICE OF REJECTION OF UNEXPIRED LEASES AND
EXECUTORY CONTRACTS**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on November 22, 2011, the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware (the “**Bankruptcy Court**”) entered the *Order (a) Authorizing Procedures by which the Debtors May Reject Certain Unexpired Leases and Executory Contracts and (b) Approving the Form and Manner of Rejection Notice* [Docket No. 302] (the “**Rejection Procedures Order**”).

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the Debtors hereby provide this “Notice of Rejection of Unexpired Leases and Executory Contracts” (the “**Rejection Notice**”) of their intent to reject all unexpired leases and executory contracts to which one or more of the Debtors is party that (a) are not being assumed and assigned to Medicis Pharmaceutical Corporation in connection with the sale of substantially all of the Debtors’ assets or (b) are not listed on Schedule 2 hereto (all remaining unexpired leases and executory contracts, the “**Leases and**

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that, pursuant to the terms of the Rejection Procedures Order, counterparties to Leases and Contracts to Be Rejected that wish to file a rejection damages claim relating to the rejection of such Leases and Contracts to Be Rejected must do so by the later of (a) December 30, 2011, the bar date established by this Court for filing proofs of claim against the Debtors, or (b) December 27, 2011, 30 days after service of this Rejection Notice. Any such rejection damages claims must be filed with the Debtors' claims, noticing, soliciting and balloting agent, BMC Group, Inc., Attn: Graceway Claims Processing, PO Box 3020, Chanhassen, MN 55317-3020 (if by first-class mail), or BMC Group Inc., Attn: Graceway Claims Processing, 18750 Lake Drive East, Chanhassen, MN 55137 (if by overnight courier or hand-delivery). If you do not properly and timely file such proof of claim, you shall be forever barred from asserting any claims for such rejection damages.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the Debtors do not waive any claims they may have against counterparties to Leases and Contracts to Be Rejected, whether or not such claims arise under, are related to the rejection of, or are independent of such Leases and Contracts to Be Rejected. 
