2. Claimant shall have an allowed administrative expense pursuant to section 503(b) of the Bankruptcy Code for all amounts, liquidated and unliquidated, contingent or otherwise, for insurance and other services provided to the Debtors after the Petition Date.
3. The Debtors (or any successor to the Debtors, including any liquidating trustee) shall pay such administrative expense in the ordinary course of business as they become due and liquidated.

4. This Order is without prejudice to Claimant's right to amend or supplement the Application.

5. This Court shall retain jurisdiction to interpret and enforce the terms of this Order and all matters arising out of this Order.
