If your Claim is against multiple Debtors, complete a separate form for each Debtor.

Creditor's Name and Address:

Fill in the name of the person or entity asserting a claim and the name and address of the person who should receive notices issued during the hankruptcy case. A separate space is provided for the payment address if it differs from the notice address. The creditor has a continuing obligation to keep the court informed of its current address. See Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure (FRBF) 2002(g).

#### 1. Amount of Claim as of Date Case Filed:

Debtor

A debtor is the person, corporation, or other entity that has filed a bankruptcy case.

A creditor is the person, corporation, or other entity owed a debt by the debtor on the date of the bankruptey filing.

#### Claim

A claim is the creditor's right to receive payment on a debt that was owed by the debtor on the date of the bankruptcy filing. See 11 U.S.C. §101 (5). A claim may he secured or processed.

#### Proof of Chair

A proof of claim is a form used by the creditor to indicate the amount of the debt owed by the debtor on the date of the bankruptcy filing. The creditor must file the form with the Claims Agent at the following address:

Secured Claim Under 11 U.S.C. §506(a)

A secured claim is one backed by a lien on property of the debtor. The claim is secured so long as the creditor has the right to be paid from the property prior to other creditors. The amount of the secured claim cannot exceed the value of the property. Any amount owed to the creditor in excess of the value of the property is an unsecured claim. Examples of liens on property include a mortgage on real estate or a security interest in a car.

A tien may be voluntarily granted by a debtor or may be obtained through a court proceeding. In some states a court judgment is a lien. A claim also may be secured if the creditor owes the debtor money (has a right to setoff),

#### Unsecured Claims

An unsecured claim is one that does not meet the requirements of a secured claim. A claim may be partly unsecured if the amount of the claim exceeds the value of the property on which the creditor has a lien.

Claim Entitled to Priority Under 11 U.S.C. §507(a) Priority claims are certain categories of unsecured Claims that are paid from the available money or property in a bankruptcy case before other unsecured chins. . .

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### Reducted

A document has been reducted when the person filing it has masked, edited out, or otherwise deleted, certain information. A creditor should reduct and use only the last four digits of any social-security, individual's tax identification, or financial-account number, all but the initials of a minor's name and only the year of my person's date of birth.

#### Evidence of Perfection

Evidence of perfection may include a mortgage, lien, certificate of title, financing statement, or other document showing that the lien has been filed or reconstant






# **Your Fund Allocation Profile**


401(k) **Existing Balance Allocation**


