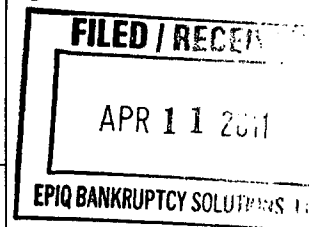

ADDENDUM TO PROOF OF CLAIM OF DEBORAH CASANOVA

1. Deborah Casanova (the “Claimant”) hereby states as follows as and for her proof of claim:

2. Pursuant to the *Order Confirming Debtors’ First Modified Joint Plan of Liquidation Under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code* [Docket No. 218] (the “Confirmation Order”) and the *Debtors’ First Modified Joint Plan of Liquidation Under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code, dated January 18, 2011* [Docket No. 140] (with all exhibits and ancillary documents thereto and as amended, supplemented or modified from time to time, the “Plan”), the Debtors rejected all obligations under any executory contracts. Plan, Article IX, Section 9.1.

3. Under and pursuant to Bylaws, Articles of Incorporation, and Operating Agreement of the respective Debtors (hereinafter, the “Organizational Documents”), and applicable state law, Debtors are obligated to indemnify and hold Claimant harmless from and against any and all liability, expenses, etc. arising from or relating to Claimant’s service as an officer and director of the Debtors (“Indemnity Obligations”). The Claimant further has rights to advancement under the Debtors’ Organizational Documents (as defined herein) and under

applicable state law (the “Advancement Obligations,” and together with the Indemnity Obligations, the “D&O Obligations”). The Claimant was entitled to rely on those rights throughout Claimant’s prepetition and postpetition service to the Debtors.

4. Indemnification and advancement are separate and distinct rights, and that a right of advancement is not dependant on a finding that the party seeking advancement is entitled to indemnification. Corporations and LLCs may confer a right to advancement that is greater than the right to indemnification. Claimant’s right to receive the costs of defense in advance does not depend upon the merits of the claims that may be asserted against Claimant, and is separate and distinct from any right of indemnification.

5. While the Debtors’ ultimate obligation to indemnify Claimant may turn on the decision of a court of competent jurisdiction regarding the nature of the Directors and Officers’ alleged actions, Debtors are nonetheless authorized and required under applicable state law to immediately advance to Claimant any and all expenses incurred by Claimant in connection with Claimant’s service as an Officer and Director of the Debtors.

6. Claimant has separate claims against the Debtors, their estates, and the Litigation Trust for the Indemnification Obligations and Advancement Obligations as set forth above, whether arising as rejection damages by operation of Section 9.1 of the Plan or otherwise.

7. While the Debtors have insurance (the “Insurance”) covering potential claims against the Claimant in Claimant’s capacity as a former officer and director, the availability of coverage is not assured. Moreover, the policy contains a self-insured retention threshold.

Harold M. Pitman Company (0980). HMP Services Holding Sub III, LLC is a Delaware limited liability company.

8. Fellow former Director Paul F. Schmidt, Jr. has to date incurred approximately \$40,000 in legal fees in his capacity as an officer and director of the Debtors, with respect to representation required for both himself and Claimant. Mr. Schmidt is the proper party to whom reimbursement for such expenditures is required to be made. To the extent that Claimant is determined to be the proper party to seek reimbursement for her allocable portion of such expenses, Claimant reserves all rights to such claim rights, for which Claimant is entitled to reimbursement by virtue of the Debtors' D&O Obligations. Claimant also has a contingent and unliquidated claim for any additional legal fees or any other expenses incurred in connection with any investigation, potential claim, claim and/or litigation relating to Claimant's service as an officer and/or director of the Debtors.

9. Claimant reserves all rights as to the effect of the Plan, the Confirmation Order, or any other aspect of the Debtors' bankruptcy cases upon the Debtors' D&O Obligations and Claimant's rights with respect to any Insurance, and whether the Plan preserved any possible causes of action. The claim is without prejudice, and nothing herein shall in any way impair Claimant's right to an administrative priority claim under 11 U.S.C. § 503. Claimant further expressly reserves any rights of setoff or recoupment. Claimant reserves all rights, without prejudice, to amend, supplement, and/or modify any proof of claim filed for any claim it may hold against Debtor.
