HOBO Information for Customers Post-Bankruptcy

Why did HOBO file for Chapter 11 bankruptcy?

Chapter 11 was filed to address financial challenges facing the companies commonly known and advertised as "HOBO" (referred to herein as "**HOBO**"). Chapter 11 will enable HOBO to manage its financial obligations, maximize the value of its assets, and treat everyone as fairly as possible under applicable law. HOBO has commenced orderly liquidation sales of existing inventory at its locations.

Does this mean you are going out of business?

HOBO is currently running going out of business sales and plans to close its doors when those sales are over, most likely before December 31st. There is a possibility that a third party may purchase HOBO and continue to operate some of the stores, but whether that happens remains to be seen.

Will the company still fulfill my custom installation?

Work on custom installation projects has been suspended. HOBO is continuing to try to work with its vendors and its bank, to try to deliver goods that are subject to deposit. We don't want to overstate what we will be able to do but we are trying.

Can I cancel my custom order and get a refund of my deposit?

Now that HOBO is in bankruptcy, it would be against the law for HOBO to honor gift cards, refund deposits, or accept returns, without a court order allowing us to do so.

HOBO's lawyers have filed a motion with the bankruptcy court seeking the authority to do these things, and that motion is being presented on Thursday, November 1st. We are asking all our customers to understand that while we cannot honor these customer requests today, we hope to be able to do so after next Thursday.

Also, customers should also know that section 507 of the Bankruptcy Code gives a priority of payment for customer deposits. The amount, however, is limited to \$1,800.

Can I return a product for a refund?

For purchases made before October 25th, see above. Not at this time, but potentially for some period of time after November 1st.

For purposes made on or after October 25th, during the Chapter 11, unfortunately, HOBO cannot issue a refund or exchange for any returned items, regardless of the reason and regardless of when purchased. All sales are final.

Can I use a gift card?

Not at this time, but potentially for some period of time after November 1st.
