**NOTICE OF HEARING ON DEBTORS' SEVENTH
OMNIBUS OBJECTION (SUBSTANTIVE) TO CLAIMS**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on December 10, 2002, the above-captioned debtors and debtors in possession (the "Debtors") filed their Seventh Omnibus Objection to Claims (Substantive) (the "Seventh Omnibus Objection") with the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware.

The following will receive a copy of the Seventh Omnibus Objection: (i) the Office of the United States Trustee, (ii) those who have filed claims that are affected by the Seventh Omnibus Objection, and (iii) all parties required to receive notice pursuant to Del. Bankr. LR 2002-1.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that:

- 1) A hearing on the Seventh Omnibus Objection will be held before the Honorable Jerry W. Venters, United States District Court, 844 North King Street, 2nd Floor, Wilmington, Delaware on **January 9, 2003 at 1:30 p.m.** (the "Claims Hearing");
- 2) Any party wishing to oppose the relief requested in the Seventh Omnibus Objection must file a written response with the Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court at 824 N. Market Street, Wilmington, Delaware 19801, and serve a copy of the response upon **Kirkland & Ellis, Attn: Jonathan Friedland, Esq., 200 East Randolph Drive, Chicago, Illinois 60601** and **Pachulski, Stang, Ziehl, Young & Jones P.C., Attn: David W. Carickhoff, Jr., Esq., 919 North Market Street, 16th Floor, P.O. Box 8705, Wilmington, Delaware 19800** so as to be received on or before **December 31, 2002 at 4:00 p.m., prevailing Eastern time.** Only those responses timely filed with the Court and received by the above will be considered by the Court;
- 3) Any response filed with the Court must contain at a minimum the following:
 - a) A caption setting forth the name of the Court, the name of the Debtor, the case number and the title of the Objection to which the response is directed;
 - b) The name of the claimant and a description of the basis for the amount of the claim;

- c) The specific factual basis and supporting legal argument upon which the party will rely in opposing the Seventh Omnibus Objection; and
 - d) Any supporting documentation, to the extent it was not included with the proof of claim previously filed with the Clerk or Claims Agent, upon which the party will rely to support the basis for and amounts asserted in the proof of claim;
- 4) If you file a response to the Seventh Omnibus Objection, you should be prepared to argue that response at the Claims Hearing. You will be permitted to make any argument telephonically, without the need to physically travel to Delaware for the Claims Hearing. To do so, you must call the Debtors' attorneys at least 24 hours prior to the scheduled hearing time.
 - 5) You need not appear at the Claims Hearing if you do not object to the relief requested. If you do not timely file and serve a response to the Seventh Omnibus Objection the relief requested in the Seventh Omnibus Objection will be granted without further notice to you. In addition, your failure to timely file a response to the Seventh Omnibus Objection shall be deemed (i) a waiver of your right to respond to the Seventh Omnibus Objection and (ii) a consent to the relief requested in the Seventh Omnibus Objection respecting your Claim;
 - 6) The Claims Hearing may be continued from time to time upon written notice provided to you;
 - 7) The Reorganizing Debtors reserve the right to object in the future to any of the claims set out in the Exhibits or body of the Seventh Omnibus Objection on any grounds. Separate notice and hearing will be scheduled for any such objection. **If you have any questions regarding your claim(s) you should contact Bankruptcy Management Corporation at (888) 909-0100.**
