**ORDER GRANTING THE RELIEF SOUGHT IN
DEBTORS' SEVENTH OMNIBUS OBJECTION TO CLAIM**

Upon the Debtors'² Seventh Omnibus Objection, seeking entry of an order disallowing and expunging certain Claims; reclassifying certain Claims; reducing and allowing certain Claims; and reclassifying, reducing and allowing certain Claims; no previous application having been made, and upon consideration of the Seventh Omnibus Objection and it appearing that this Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; and it appearing that this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2); and it appearing that venue of the proceeding and this Seventh Omnibus Objection is proper pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; and due and proper notice having been given, and no further notice being required; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing, it is hereby

ORDERED that the relief sought in the Seventh Omnibus Objection is granted; and it is further

ORDERED that the Reclassified Claims on Exhibit A attached to the Seventh Omnibus Objection are reclassified in the amount and with the priority indicated thereon; and it is further

ORDERED that the Reclassified, Reduced and Allowed Claim on Exhibit B attached is reclassified, reduced and allowed in the amount and with the priority indicated thereon; and it is further

ORDERED that the Reduced and Allowed Claim on Exhibit C attached to the Seventh Omnibus Objection is reduced and allowed in the amount and to the extent indicated thereon; and it is further

ORDERED that the No Liability Claims on Exhibit D attached to the Seventh Omnibus Objection are disallowed and expunged for all purposes; and it is further

ORDERED that the Debtors reserve their rights to object to any claim listed on the exhibit to this order for any reason; and it is further

ORDERED that this Court shall retain jurisdiction to hear and determine all matters arising from the implementation of this Order.
