MOTION FOR ADMISSION OF JENNIFER E. NIEMANN TO PRACTICE PRO HAC VICE, DESIGNATION OF LOCAL COUNSEL, AND CONSENT TO ACT


5. Movant certifies that she has not previously moved for admission pro hac vice to appear in a proceeding in the United States District Court for the Middle District of Florida.


WHEREFORE, Movant respectfully requests entry of an order authorizing his/her admission to practice and represent the Creditor in this case and any related proceedings.
