ORDER APPROVING APPLICATION, AS SUPPLEMENTED, OF FRANK M. WOLFF AND FRANK MARTIN WOLFF, P.A. AS ATTORNEYS FOR DEBTOR AND DEBTOR-IN-POSSESSION, FOR AWARD OF COMPENSATION AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES

This case came on for hearing on November 14, 2018, to consider and act upon the application of Frank M. Wolff and Frank Martin Wolff, P.A. (collectively, "FMWPA") for: (i) award of compensation for services rendered and reimbursement of expenses (Doc. No. 295); and (ii) supplement to application of FMWPA for award of compensation for services rendered and reimbursement of expenses (Doc. No. 355) (collectively, the "Application") for the period November 7, 2017 through November 12, 2018 (the "Application Period").

Having considered the Application, the representations of counsel and the views of other interested parties present at the hearing, noting that no objections have been filed, and considering the extent, nature and value of services rendered, taking into account relevant factors specified in 11 U.S.C. §330(a), the Court finds that amount of the requested fees and expenses is reasonable.

Accordingly, it is ORDERED that:

- 1. The Application is granted.
- 2. Fees in the amount of \$220,100.00 and expenses in the amount of \$2,633.71, for a total of \$222,733.71, are allowed as an administrative expense in the Chapter 11 case.
 - 3. FMWPA may apply its retainer of \$102,382.50 against this award.
- 4. The Debtor is authorized and directed to pay the remaining balance of \$120,351.21 from the proceeds of the sale of the Auction Properties.

Attorney, Frank M. Wolff, is directed to serve a copy of this order on interested parties and file a proof of service within 3 days of the entry of the order.
