This matter came on for hearing on May 11, 2010, at 2:30 p.m., in Courtroom 5D of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Central District of California, before the Honorable Robert Kwan, United States Bankruptcy Judge. Kerri A. Lyman, Esq. of Irell & Manella LLP appeared telephonically on behalf of James C. Gianulias ("Gianulias") and Cameo Homes, a California corporation ("Cameo"), the substantively consolidated debtors and debtors-in-possession (the "Debtors").
