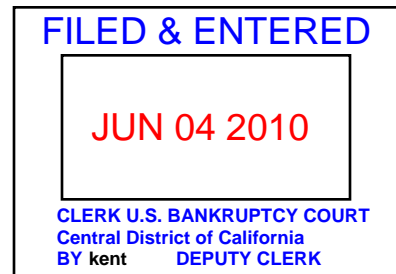

7 have the right to object to Claim 4-2 on any grounds whatsoever except that the Debtors (or their
8 successors-in-interest) will not object to Claim No. 4-2 on the grounds that the same was filed
9 after the claims bar date as Claim 4-1 was timely filed; and

10 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the Stipulation resolves the issues raised in the
11 Limited Objection filed by the Laing Creditors [Docket No. 654].
