In February of 2010 we purchased a leather sofa from Jennifer Convertibles at their Birmingham, Michigan store. We took delivery on Feb. 17. Later found a flaw in the cushions and called and filed a claim. The price of the sofa was \$667.80.

We called for an inspection on March 16, and they came to our house for an inspection. They said the cushions would be replaced.

We received a letter dated April 1, 2010, saying the claim had been received and replacement would take from 4 to 6 weeks for domestically produced items and 10 to 12 weeks for imports. Indications were that the items had been ordered.

In July we checked on progress and were told they would follow up and let us know. On August 11, a follow up call was made and no one answered the phone. On the 13th we received a call that they had gone bankrupt and the claim could not be fulfilled.

Lately they continue to run ads in the New York Times Sunday magazine so presumably they are still in business. Any call to their phone number, 516 496 1900, is an answering machine advising to contact the location where the purchase was made and of course there is no answer there.

If the company is still in business, the claim should be satisfied. We want the replacement pillows or our money back for the sofa.....
