**ORDER GRANTING MOTION OF ACADIA CORTLANDT, LLC
FOR PERMISSION TO FILE A LATE OBJECTION TO THE DEBTORS' AMENDED
CURE SCHEDULE, SUSTAINING ACADIA'S OBJECTION, AND DIRECTING
JENNIFER CONVERTIBLES, INC. TO CURE ITS DEFAULT UNDER THE LEASE BY
MAKING IMMEDIATE PAYMENT OF OUTSTANDING POST-PETITION RENT**

Upon the Motion of Acadia Cortlandt, LLC ("Acadia") for permission to file a late Objection to the Debtors' Amended Cure Schedule, and for an Order sustaining Acadia's Objection and directing the Reorganized Debtor, Jennifer Convertibles, Inc., to cure its default under its Lease with Acadia for non-residential real property by making immediate payment to Acadia of outstanding post-petition rent; a hearing having been held on the Motion on May 4, 2011, and it appearing that the relief sought in the Motion and the entry of this Order are appropriate and necessary upon consideration of the Motion and all of the proceedings before the

ORDERED that the Motion is GRANTED; and it is further

ORDERED that Acadia's Motion for permission to file a late Objection to the Amended Cure Schedule is GRANTED; and it is further

ORDERED that Acadia's Objection to the Amended Cure Schedule is SUSTAINED; and it is further

ORDERED that Reorganized Debtor Jennifer Convertibles, Inc. is directed to cure its default under the Lease by making immediate payment to Acadia of \$54,989.83 in outstanding post-petition rent; and it is further

ORDERED that the Debtors are directed to pay the attorneys' fees incurred by Acadia in connection with its Motion; and it is further

ORDERED that this Court shall retain jurisdiction over any and all matters arising from the interpretation and implementation of this Order.
