**SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER GRANTING TRUST ADMINISTRATOR'S
THIRD (NON-SUBSTANTIVE) OMNIBUS OBJECTION**

Upon consideration of the Trust Administrator's Third (Non-Substantive) Omnibus Objection to Certain (A) Wrong Debtor Claims; (B) Duplicative Claims; (C) Satisfied Claims; (D) Reorganized Debtor's Liability Claims; and (E) Amended and Superseded Claims (the "Third Omnibus Objection")² requesting entry of an order modifying claim number 255 filed by PMAIC (Pennsylvania Manufacturer's Assoc. Ins. Co.; and the Court having jurisdiction to consider the Third Omnibus Objection and the relief requested therein pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157; and venue being proper before this Court pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; and it appearing from the affidavit of service filed with the Court and from the record that due and proper notice of the Third Omnibus Objection having been provided; and the Court having reviewed and considered the Third Omnibus Objection; and a hearing having been held to consider the relief requested in the Third Omnibus Objection; and upon all of the proceedings had before this Court and after due deliberation and sufficient causes appearing therefore:
