


NOTICE TO EACH DEFENDANT



COMPLAINT

1. At all times mentioned herein, the defendant, K-MART Corporation, owned, maintained and operated a store which is located at 589 Bridgeport Avenue, Milford, Connecticut, to which it invited the general public.

2. On or about September 26, 2000, the plaintiff, Lucretia Siedenberg, was a patron in the defendant's store.

3. At all times mentioned herein, said property and premises were controlled, possessed, managed and/or maintained by the defendant.

4. As the plaintiff was shopping in said store, she was suddenly and without warning struck in the head, neck and left shoulder by a chair, which had fallen from a shelf above the plaintiff, causing the plaintiff to suffer the following injuries and damages.

5. As a result thereof, the plaintiff, Lucretia Siedenberg, sustained injuries of a serious, painful and permanent nature in that she sustained a musculo-ligamentous sprain to the left shoulder with tendonitis; a tear to the left rotator cuff, which required surgery; a musculo-

- ligamentous sprain of the cervical spine, superimposed upon a pre-existing condition; a musculo-ligamentous sprain to the lumbosacral spine, superimposed upon a pre-existing condition; an injury to the temporomandibular joint; concussion; dizziness; headaches; emotional distress; humiliation; and, a general shock to her nervous system.

6. As a further result, the plaintiff incurred expenses for her medical care and treatment and may continue to do so in the future.

7. In addition, the plaintiff was unable to enjoy her recreation and hobbies for a period of time, which may continue in the future, all to her loss.

8. The injuries and damages suffered by the plaintiff, Lucretia Siedenbug, were the result of the carelessness and negligence of the defendant, K-MART Corporation, acting through its agents and employees, in that it failed to properly inspect the premises; in that it caused or allowed and permitted said chair to be stored in a dangerous, unsafe and defective condition; in that it caused, allowed and permitted said chair to remain improperly and unsafely placed on its shelf; in that it failed to provide a safe and sufficient storage compartment for said chair, although at the time it knew or should have known safe storage existed; and, in that it failed to properly secure said chair so that it would not fall from the shelf.

The plaintiff claims monetary damages within the jurisdiction of this Court.


