Plaintiff Pro Cycle Assembly, Inc. complaining of the Defendant, alleges as follows:

- 1. Plaintiff Pro Cycle Assembly, Inc. ("Pro Cycle") is a North Carolina corporation with its registered office in Greensboro, Guilford County, North Carolina.
- 2. Upon information and belief, Defendant K Mart Corporation ("K Mart") is a Michigan corporation with a registered office in Wake County, North Carolina and its principal office in a state other than North Carolina.
- 3. At all times relevant hereto, Pro Cycle has been and is in the business of providing on-site services in the assembly of bicycles, lawn mowers and other lawn care equipment, outdoor furniture, grills, and similar products, for in-store display and for consumer purchase, on behalf of retailers such as K Mart and others.
- 4. Through authorized representatives at various of K Mart's stores, Pro Cycle provided assembly services to K Mart at various times from July, 2000 through November, 2001. A true and accurate schedule of store locations, invoice numbers, invoice dates, and invoice amounts due from K Mart to Pro Cycle is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein as though fully set forth.

FIRST CLAIM FOR RELIEF

BREACH OF CONTRACT

- 5. Pro Cycle realleges and incorporates herein by reference paragraphs 1through 4 of the Complaint as though fully set forth.
- 6. Pro Cycle and K Mart entered into various contracts, as referenced in Exhibit A, pursuant to which Pro Cycle was to perform, and did perform, assembly services for K Mart in exchange for receipt of payment from K Mart.
- 7. Pro Cycle performed all of its obligations under the contracts, and has performed any and all other conditions to its entitlement to payment under the contracts.
- 8. Under the contracts, K Mart was to pay the invoice amount within thirty (30) days of the date of such invoices. K Mart breached each of the contracts referenced in Exhibit "A" by failing to pay the amounts due, notwithstanding demand for payment by Pro Cycle.
- 9. Pro Cycle is entitled to Judgment against K Mart for breach of contract in the principal amount of \$17,385.00, together with interest at the legal rate from the dates such invoice amounts became due.

SECOND CLAIM FOR RELIEF

QUANTUM MERUIT

Pleading in the alternative, Pro Cycle alleges as follows:

- 10. Pro Cycle realleges and incorporates herein by reference paragraphs 1through 4 of the Complaint as though fully set forth.
- 11. K Mart requested, desired and ordered that Pro Cycle provide and perform its assembly services at its various stores, which Pro Cycle provided and performed as requested.
 - 12. Pro Cycle reasonably expected K Mart to compensate it for the services and

materials provided.

- 13. K Mart knew or reasonably should have known that Pro Cycle expected compensation for the services and materials provided.
- 14. Pro Cycle is entitled to recover the fair value of these services and materials which they have provided to K Mart, which amount is in excess of \$10,000.00.

THIRD CLAIM FOR RELIEF

UNJUST ENRICHMENT

Pleading in the alternative, Pro Cycle alleges as follows:

- 15. Pro Cycle realleges and incorporates herein by reference paragraphs 1through 4 of the Complaint as though fully set forth.
- 16. Pro Cycle provided and furnished certain services and materials to improve K Mart's products and services offered to customers.
- 17. Pro Cycle is entitled to a reasonable and fair price for the services and materials provided to K Mart.
- 18. Pro Cycle rendered benefits to K Mart under such circumstances that it is only fair that Pro Cycle be compensated, and compensation in an amount in excess of \$10,000.00 is necessary to prevent the unjust enrichment of K Mart at the expense of Pro Cycle.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff Pro Cycle Assembly, Inc. respectfully requests that: (a) this Court enter Judgment in its favor and against Defendant K Mart Corporation, awarding Pro Cycle damages in the principal amount of \$17,235.00 under its first claim for relief or, alternatively, in an amount in excess of \$10,000.00 as to its second and third claims for relief, together with all accruing pre-judgment interest at the legal rate; (b) the costs of this action be taxed against Defendant; and (c) the Court award to Pro Cycle such other and further relief as it deems just and
