COMES NOW Plaintiff GLENDA BAKER and states her Complaint for Bodily Injury showing this honorable Court as follows:

1.

The Plaintiff fell in K Mart Store #3602 located at 2420 Wisteria Drive, Snellville, Georgia 30078 on December 26, 1999. As a result of that fall, the Plaintiff broke her left femur and sustained other injuries.

Defendant K MART CORPORATION is a foreign corporation authorized to do business in the state of Georgia and may be served by service on its registered agent, Corporation Process Company, 180 Cherokee Street, NE, Marietta, Cobb County, Georgia 30060.

Defendant JOHN DOE CORPORATION is named as a Defendant in the event that the K MART location above-described in paragraph No. 1 was owned or operated by a different entity on December 26, 1999.
