COMPLAINT

COME NOW Plaintiffs, PATRICIA FRASCA and PETER FRASCA, by and through their undersigned attorneys and hereby file suit against Defendant, K MART CORPORATION (hereinafter referred to as "K MART"), based on the following allegations:

ALLEGATIONS COMMON TO ALL COUNTS

- 1. This is an action for damages which exceed the sum of Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00).
- 2. At all times material hereto, Defendant, K MART, was a Florida corporation operating and conducting business in the State of Florida and more specifically at K MART Store #3164 located on North Lake Boulevard in Lake Park, Palm Beach County, Florida.
- 3. At all times material hereto, Defendant, K MART, owed a duty to Plaintiff, PATRICIA FRASCA, and other members of the general public, similarly situated, to keep its property and

premises in a reasonably safe condition and to protect Plaintiff,
PATRICIA FRASCA, from dangers which the business or its
employees, were or should have been aware of.

- 4. On or about August 8, 2001, Plaintiff, PATRICIA FRASCA, was a patron/business invitee of Defendant, K MART, at the above-mentioned location.
- 5. At that time and place, Plaintiff, PATRICIA FRASCA, was in the process of entering a shopping cart corral located in the parking lot directly in front of Defendant's business.
- 6. At all times material hereto, the aforementioned shopping cart corral was owned, controlled and/or maintained by Defendant, K MART.
- 7. At all times material hereto, Defendant, K MART, owed a duty to Plaintiff, PATRICIA FRASCA, and other members of the general public similarly situated, to keep and maintain this shopping cart corral in a reasonably safe condition and to protect Plaintiff, PATRICIA FRASCA, from dangers which the business or it's employees, were or should have been aware of.
- 8. At that time and place, a portion of the shopping cart corral was raised and sticking up from the surface of the parking lot creating a tripping hazard at the entrance of the shopping cart corral.

COUNT I

9. The dangerous and/or hazardous condition of the raised portion of the shopping cart corral was created by Defendant,

K MART.

- 10. At all times material hereto, Defendant, K MART, was negligent in one or more, but not limited to the following respects:
- a) Negligently permitting the dangerous and/or hazardous condition of the shopping cart corral to remain in an area where it knew or should have known customers would travel;
- b) Failing to take reasonable steps to correct or remedy the dangerous and/or hazardous condition created by the shopping cart corral;
- c) Failing to exercise reasonable care in the inspection of its premises including the shopping cart corral;
- d) Negligently repairing the dangerous and/or hazardous created by the raised portion of the shopping cart corral;
- e) Failing to warn Plaintiff of the existence or presence of the dangerous and/or hazardous condition created by the shopping cart corral;
- f) Failing to exercise reasonable care under all of the relevant surrounding circumstances.
- 11. As a direct and proximate result of the aforementioned negligence, Plaintiff, PATRICIA FRASCA, was caused to trip and fall over the above-mentioned dangerous and/or hazardous condition causing injury in and about her body.
- 12. The aforementioned dangerous and/or hazardous condition was known to Defendant, K MART, it's agents, or employees or had

existed for a sufficient length of time so that Defendant, K MART, should have known about.

13. As a direct and proximate result, Plaintiff, PATRICIA FRASCA, was injured in and about her body, suffered aggravation of a pre-existing condition, pain and suffering, disability, disfigurement, impairment of working ability, mental anguish, loss of the enjoyment of life, and Plaintiff, PATRICIA FRASCA, has incurred medical expenses in the care and treatment of said injuries; all of said injuries are permanent within a reasonable degree of medical probability.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff, PATRICIA FRASCA, demands judgment for damages against Defendant, K MART CORPORATION, and further demands trial by jury.

COUNT II

- 14. Plaintiff realleges paragraphs 8 through 12 as if fully set forth herein.
- 15. At all times material hereto, Plaintiff's were married to each other and living together as husband and wife.
- 16. As a result, Plaintiff, PETER FRASCA, has been in past and will in the future be deprived of the comfort, society, and consortium of his wife, PATRICIA FRASCA.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff, PETER FRASCA, demands judgment for damages against Defendant, K MART CORPORATION, and further demands trial by jury.
