ORDER


The above matter having been brought before the Court upon Motion by Anthony Granato, Esquire, attorney for Claimant, Kevin Meiswinkel, for an Order vacating that part of the 14th and 19th Omnibus Order disallowing Kevin Meiswinkel's claims and reviving the claims asserted by him against Kmart and good cause having been shown;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- (i) That the 14th and 19th Omnibus Orders disallowing Kevin Meiswinkel's claims are hereby vacated;
- (ii) Kevin Meiswinkel's claims against Kmart Corporation are hereby revived; and
- (iii) Nothing herein shall be deemed to remove the claim of Kevin Meiswinkel from the injunctive provisions of Kmart's Plan of Reorganization or Section 524 of the Bankruptcy Code; provided that both Kmart and Kevin Meiswinkel reserve the right to seek relief from such injunctive provisions through a separate motion.
