**ORDER GRANTING NEW ENGLAND H.V.A./C. SERVICES
CORPORATION LIMITED RELIEF FROM THE AUTOMATIC STAY**


Upon consideration of the Motion of New England H.V.A./C. Services Corporation ("New England") for an Order Granting Relief from the Automatic Stay (the "Motion"), and the objection of the Debtor to the Motion, it is hereby:

ORDERED that the automatic stay is lifted for the limited purpose of permitting the Debtor to prosecute any case dispositive motions (the "Case Dispositive Motions") to conclusion in the Action¹ in the Superior Court for the State of New Jersey and New England to respond to any Case Dispositive Motions as appropriate; and it is further

ORDERED that the Case Dispositive Motions shall be filed on or before March 31, 2004; and it is further

ORDERED that the relief granted herein is without prejudice to the Debtor to move this Court for an estimation hearing, and is without prejudice to New England to seek further relief from the automatic stay.
