AGREED ORDER

This matter coming before the court for status and the court being advised that the parties have reached an agreement as to the amendment of the Court's previously entered orders of January 22, 2001 and March 12, 2001, it is hereby ordered that:

1. On January 22, 2001, the Court entered an Agreed Order for Immediate and Preliminary Injunction (the "January 2001 Order").

Paragraph 6 of said Order provided that:

Effective January 19, 2001, Lockformer shall provide potable bottled water, or reimburse all reasonable costs for alternative drinking water, to all residences not on public water supply located on the north and south sides of Front Street, Reidy Road, Hitchcock Avenue, and Gamble Drive. This area will be bound to the west by Kingston Avenue and will include any homes on the east side of Kingston Avenue and bounded to the east by Westview Lane including any homes on the east side of Westview Lane. Water provisions or reimbursement shall continue until such further order of the court or written agreement by the parties.

2. On March 12, 2001, the Court entered an order (the "March 2001 Order") amending paragraph 6 of the January 2001 Order to read as

follows:

Effective January 19, 2001, Lockformer shall provide potable bottled water, or reimburse all reasonable costs for alternative drinking water, to all residences not on public water supply located on the north and south sides of Front Street, Reidy Road, Hitchcock Avenue, and Gamble Drive. This area will be bound to the west by Kingston Avenue and will include any homes on the east side of Kingston Avenue and bounded to the east by Westview Lane including any homes on the east side of Westview Lane. In addition, the same arrangements shall be made available to the residences in un-incorporated Lisle, not on public water supply located on the east side of Kingston Avenue, starting with the first house south of 59th Street that is not facing on 59th Street, continuing south on the east side of Kingston until it ends at 62nd Street, both sides of 61st Street, from Kingston east to the end of the street, and including Cliff Court, Ivanhoe Drive south of 61st Street and the three homes on 62nd Street, and homes on Elm Street between 61st and 62nd Street. Water provisions or reimbursement shall continue until such further order of the court or written agreement by the parties. *[Additional language in italics.]*

3. Pursuant to the parties agreement reached herein, Paragraph 6 of the January 2001 Order, as amended by the March 2001 Order, shall now read as follows:

Effective January 19, 2001, Lockformer shall provide potable bottled water, or reimburse all reasonable costs for alternative bottled drinking water, to all residences not on public water supply located on the north and south sides of Front Street, Reidy Road, Hitchcock Avenue, and Gamble Drive. This area will be bound to the west by Kingston Avenue and will include any homes on the east side of Kingston Avenue and bounded to the east by Westview Lane including any homes on the east side of Westview Lane. In addition, the same arrangements shall be made available to the residences in un-incorporated Lisle, not on public water supply located on the east side of Kingston Avenue, starting with the first house south of 59th Street that is not facing on 59th Street, continuing south on the east side of Kingston until it ends at 62nd Street, both sides of 61st Street, from Kingston east to the end of the street, and including Cliff Court, Ivanhoe Drive south of 61st Street and the three homes on 62nd Street, and homes on Elm Street between 61st and 62nd Street. This arrangement shall also apply to the homes in Suburban Estates, 3 homes on 63rd Street which have been previously identified to Defendants, and an area defined as the east side of Walnut Avenue from the South side of 59th Street to College Street and both sides of Katrine Avenue from the South side of 59th Street

to College Street. Water provisions or reimbursement shall continue until such further order of the court or written agreement by the parties. [Additional language in bold.]

4. Nothing contained in this Order shall be construed as an admission of any wrongful conduct or violation of any applicable statute, law or regulations or of any liability whatsoever against the Defendants, nor shall anything in this Order be deemed a finding of fact or adjudication by this Court of any of the facts or claims contained in the Complaint and/or the Complaint of Intervenor filed herein.
5. Nothing herein shall be deemed to prejudice or abrogate Defendants' right to seek contribution and/or reimbursement from any third parties responsible for the soil and groundwater contamination alleged by Plaintiff in its Complaint and/or the Complaint of Intervenor filed herein.
6. All other terms of the January 22 and March 12, 2001 Orders remain in full force and effect.
7. That this matter is continued to March 31, 2003 at 10:00 a.m./p.m. for Status.


