**FUTURE CLAIMANTS' REPRESENTATIVE'S MOTION PURSUANT TO DEL. L.R.
9006-1(e) FOR AN ORDER SHORTENING THE TIME FOR NOTICE OF THE
HEARING TO CONSIDER THE FUTURE CLAIMANTS' REPRESENTATIVE'S
MOTION FOR SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER CLARIFYING THE SCOPE OF
APPOINTMENT OF THE LEGAL REPRESENTATIVE FOR FUTURE CLAIMANTS**

Eric D. Green (the "Future Claimants' Representative"), as the legal representative for Future Claimants (defined herein below) in the above-captioned case, having filed his Motion for Supplemental Order Clarifying the Scope of Appointment of the Legal Representative for Future Claimants (the "Motion") hereby moves this Court, pursuant to Rule 9006-1(e) of the Local Rules of Practice and Procedure of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware (the "Local Rules"), for entry of an order shortening the time for notice of the hearing to consider the Motion so that the matter may be heard at the hearing to consider the confirmation of the plan of reorganization in this case, currently scheduled for July 28, 2004 at 11:30 a.m.¹ In support thereof, the Future Claimants' Representative respectfully submits the following:

¹ All terms not defined herein shall have the meaning supplied to them in the Fourth Amended Chapter 11 Plan of Reorganization Proposed by Met-Coil Systems Corporation and Mestek, Inc., as Co-Proponents, dated June 22, 2004 (the "Plan"), and except as expressly stated herein, in the event of any inconsistency between the Plan and this Motion, the Plan will control.

1. The Future Claimants' Representative submits that there is sufficient cause to justify shortening the notice period for the hearing on approval of the relief requested in the Motion.

2. The Local Rules require fifteen (15) days' notice (eighteen (18) days if service is by mail) prior to the hearing for the Motion. See Del. Bankr. L.R. 9006-1(c). Pursuant to Local Rule 9006-1(e), however, such period may be shortened by Order of the Court upon written motion specifying the exigencies supporting shortened notice.

3. As set forth more fully in the Motion, the Future Claimants' Representative seeks to supplement the previously entered order directing his appointment to conform to defined terms in the recently filed Fourth Amended Chapter 11 Plan of Reorganization Proposed by Met-Coil Systems Corporation and Mestek, Inc., as Co-Proponents, dated June 22, 2004 (the "Plan"). Because the relief sought in the Motion is intertwined with this Court's consideration of the confirmation of the Plan, the Future Claimants' Representative seeks consideration of the Motion concurrently with the confirmation of the Plan. Furthermore, the Future Claimants' Representative has informed the Debtor and the committee of unsecured creditors (the "Committee") in this case, and each of these parties have indicated that they will not contest the shortening of notice for the Motion.


4. The Future Claimants' Representative will serve the Motion by facsimile, hand delivery or overnight courier. In light of the nature of the relief sought in the Motion, and the expedited manner of service, the Future Claimants' Representative submits that (i) there is sufficient cause to justify shortening the applicable notice period for the Motion; (ii) that a shortened notice period will be sufficient for the entry of the order on the Motion and (iii) that notice to the parties identified below will be adequate and sufficient. As such, the Future

Claimants' Representative respectfully requests that the hearing on the Motion be held on July 28, 2004 at 11:30 a.m. (ET). The Future Claimants' Representative further proposes that any responses or objections to the Motion must be in writing, filed with the Court, and served upon and received by the undersigned counsel for the Future Claimants' Representative on or before July 23, 2004 at 4:00 p.m. (ET).

WHEREFORE, the Future Claimants' Representative respectfully requests that the Court enter an Order scheduling a hearing on the Motion for July 28, 2004 at 11:30 a.m. (ET) and requiring that any responses to such relief requested in the Motion be filed and served so as to be received on or before July 23, 2004 at 4:00 p.m. (ET).
