3. Goldberg Kohn shall be compensated in accordance with the procedures set forth

in §327, 330 and 331 of the Bankruptcy Code and such Bankruptcy Rules and the Local

Bankruptcy Rules as may then be applicable, from time to time, and such procedures as may be

fixed by order of this Court.

4. Any retainer received from the Debtor shall be applied to any fees and expenses

allowed by court order in this case prior to seeking reimbursement for any such allowed fees and

expenses from other sources.

5. This Court retains jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or related to

the implementation of this Order.
