**ORDER AUTHORIZING THE DEBTOR PURSUANT TO BANKRUPTCY CODE § 107(b)(1) AND BANKRUPTCY RULE 9018 TO FILE *UNDER SEAL* EXHIBIT A TO ITS MOTION TO APPROVE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT WITH ACE PURSUANT TO BANKRUPTCY CODE § 105 AND BANKRUPTCY RULE 9019**

Upon the motion (the "**Motion to File Under Seal**")<sup>1</sup> of the debtor and debtor in possession (the "**Debtor**") in the above-captioned chapter 11 case (the "**Case**"), for entry of an Order authorizing the Debtor pursuant to Bankruptcy Code § 107(b)(1) and Bankruptcy Rule 9018 to file *under seal* Exhibit A to its motion to approve settlement agreement with ACE pursuant to Bankruptcy Code § 105 and Bankruptcy Rule 9019, and it appearing that the Court has jurisdiction over the Motion to File Under Seal pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2); and due and adequate notice of the Motion to File Under Seal having been given; and it appearing that no other or further notice need be given; and this Court having determined that granting the relief requested in the Motion to File Under Seal is in the best interests of the Debtor, its estate and its creditors; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefore,


**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:**

1. The Motion to File Under Seal is granted.
2. The Debtor is authorized to file and maintain *under seal* Exhibit A to its Motion To Approve Settlement Agreement with ACE Pursuant To Bankruptcy Code § 105 and Bankruptcy Rule 9019.
