**SECOND INTERIM AND FINAL FEE APPLICATION OF CBIZ VALUATION  
GROUP, INC., AS VALUATION CONSULTANT FOR DEBTOR AND DEBTOR-  
IN-POSSESSION, FOR ALLOWANCE OF INTERIM AND FINAL  
COMPENSATION AND FOR INTERIM AND FINAL REIMBURSEMENT OF  
ALL ACTUAL AND NECESSARY EXPENSES INCURRED FOR THE PERIOD  
OCTOBER 31, 2003 THROUGH OCTOBER 19, 2004**

Upon the Second Interim and Final Application (the "Application") of CBIZ Valuation Group, Inc. ("CBIZ"), valuation consultant for Met-Coil Systems, LLC (f/k/a Met-Coil Systems Corporation), debtor and debtor-in-possession (the "Debtor") in the above-captioned case, for allowance of compensation for actual, reasonable and necessary services rendered and for reimbursement of all actual, reasonable and necessary expenses incurred for the period October 31, 2003 through and including October 19, 2004; the Court having reviewed the Application; the Court having jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; the Court being duly advised in the premises, and after notice and opportunity for a hearing to consider the Application; and upon the record and after due deliberation thereon; and sufficient cause appearing therefor:

**IT IS HEREBY FOUND, DECREED AND ORDERED THAT:**

1. The Application is GRANTED.

2. Capitalized terms not otherwise defined herein shall have the meanings ascribed to such terms in the Application.

3. Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 330 and 331, CBIZ is allowed interim compensation of \$576.00 for actual, reasonable and necessary professional services rendered to or on behalf of the Debtor during the Interim Application Period and interim reimbursement of \$81.38 for actual, reasonable and necessary expenses incurred during the Interim Application Period, the Debtor's prior payment of such amount is approved.

4. Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 330 and 331, CBIZ is allowed final compensation of \$20,752.25 for actual, reasonable and necessary professional services rendered to or on behalf of the Debtor during the Final Application Period and final reimbursement of \$1,064.57 for actual, reasonable and necessary expenses incurred during the Final Application Period.
