**ORDER SHORTENING TIME REGARDING MESTEK, INC.'S
MOTION FOR ENTRY OF ORDER APPROVING
STIPULATION BY AND BETWEEN DEBTOR,
OFFICIAL COMMITTEE OF UNSECURED CREDITORS
AND MESTEK, INC. EXTENDING INVESTIGATIVE PERIOD**

Upon the motion (the "Motion") of Mestek, Inc.
