**ORDER ON MOTION OF THE OFFICIAL COMMITTEE OF
UNSECURED CREDITORS TO COMPEL
THE DEBTOR AND MESTEK TO COMPLY WITH RULE 2004 ORDER**

This matter having been brought before the Court on the *Motion of The Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors to Compel the Debtor to Comply with Rule 2004 Order* (the “Motion”); and the Court having considered the Motion and finding that (a) the Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1334; (b) this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b); and (c) notice of the Motion was sufficient under the circumstances; and the Court further determining that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Motion establish just cause for the relief granted herein.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The Motion is GRANTED.
2. Compelling the production of disputed documents; and
3. Directing the Debtor’s President, Charles F. Kuoni, III, to answer completely the Committee’s questions concerning settlement discussions and other matters relating to the environmental litigation to which the Joint Defense Agreement was previously asserted; and

4. Directing that the Debtor and Mestek may not invoke the joint defense privilege or common defense rule in any other Rule 2004 examination or in response to any discovery request made by the Committee as part of its investigation.
