reimbursements for actual and necessary expenses incurred by the professional in connection

with these cases.

G. The legal and factual bases set forth in the Final Application and at the Hearing

establish just cause for the relief granted herein.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Final Application is GRANTED on a final basis as set forth herein.

2. Pursuant to an agreement between applicant and the Office of the United States

Trustee, the applicant agreed to reduce the expenses sought in it Final Application by \$303.29.

3. To the extent that any of the amounts set forth herein have not been paid, the

Oldco M Distribution Trust (the "<u>Trust</u>") is authorized and directed to pay the applicant the sums

set forth in Schedule "1" under the column headings "Fees to be Paid to the Extent Currently

Unpaid," and "Expenses Awarded" except as otherwise provided herein.

expenses paid as approved in the First Interim Order, Second Interim Order and this Order.
