**ORDER SHORTENING TIME OF NOTICE
WITH RESPECT TO A HEARING ON DEBTORS' REQUEST FOR
AN ORDER (A) APPROVING BIDDING PROCEDURES FOR THE SALE OF
THE DEBTORS' POWERTRAIN BUSINESS GROUP, (B) APPROVING
CERTAIN BIDDER PROTECTIONS AND (C) SCHEDULING A FINAL SALE
HEARING AND APPROVING THE FORM AND MANNER OF NOTICE THEREOF**

This matter coming before the Court on the Motion of Debtors, Pursuant to Local Bankruptcy Rule 9006-1(b), for an Order Shortening Time of Notice With Respect to the Debtors' Request for an Order (a) Approving Bidding Procedures for the Sale of the Debtors' Powertrain Group, (b) Approving Certain Bidder Protections and (c) Scheduling a Final Sale Hearing and Approving the Form and Manner of Notice Thereof (the "Motion to Expedite"),¹ filed by the debtors and debtors in possession in the above-captioned cases (collectively, the "Debtors"); the Court having reviewed the Motion to Expedite; and the Court having found that (a) the Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334, (b) this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b) and (c) notice of the Motion to Expedite was sufficient under the circumstances; and the Court having determined that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Motion to Expedite establish just cause for the relief granted herein;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Motion to Expedite is GRANTED as set forth herein.
2. An expedited hearing on the bidding procedures relief requested in the Bidding and Sale Procedures Motion is scheduled for June 24, 2009 at 2:00 p.m. (ET). Any objections to the proposed Bidding Procedures Order shall be filed and served in accordance with the Case Management Order so that they are received by June 23, 2009 at 2:00 p.m. (ET).
3. The Debtors are ordered to serve the Bidding and Sale Procedures Motion and a notice in substantially the form attached to the Motion to Expedite as Exhibit 1 by email, facsimile, hand delivery or overnight delivery service on the General List and Special Service list established by the Case Management Order and those additional parties receiving notice of the Bidding and Sale Procedures Motion. Completion of this service shall be deemed sufficient and adequate notice in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Bankruptcy Code, the Bankruptcy Rules and the Local Bankruptcy Rules of this Court.
