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**ORDER SHORTENING THE NOTICE
PERIOD ON THE MOTION OF DEBTORS AND DEBTORS
IN POSSESSION FOR AN ORDER, PURSUANT TO SECTION 365(d)(4)
OF THE BANKRUPTCY CODE, EXTENDING THEIR TIME TO ASSUME
OR REJECT UNEXPIRED LEASES OF NONRESIDENTIAL REAL PROPERTY**

This matter coming before the Court on the Motion for an Order Shortening the Notice Period on the Motion of Debtors and Debtors in Possession for an Order, Pursuant to Section 365(d)(4) of the Bankruptcy Code, Extending Their Time to Assume or Reject Unexpired Leases of Nonresidential Real Property (the "Expedited Motion"),¹ filed by the above-captioned debtors and debtors in possession (the "Debtor"); the Court having reviewed the Expedited Motion; and the Court having found that (a) the Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334, (b) this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b), (c) cause exists to hear the Lease Deadline Motion on an expedited basis and (d) notice of the Expedited Motion was sufficient under the circumstances; and the Court having determined that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Expedited Motion establish just cause for the relief granted herein;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Expedited Motion is GRANTED in its entirety.
2. An expedited hearing on the Lease Deadline Motion is set for August 20, 2009 at 2:00 p.m.
3. Objections to the Lease Deadline Motion must be filed, served and received no later than August 18, 2009 at 12:00 p.m.
4. This Court shall retain jurisdiction to resolve all matters relating to the implementation of this Order.
