



3. I have read and am familiar with the Uniform Local Rules for the United States District Court for the Northern and Southern Districts of Mississippi.



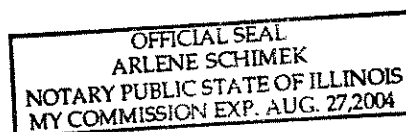
