ORDER PURSUANT TO 11 U.S.C. § 1121(d) EXTENDING
DEBTOR'S EXCLUSIVE PERIODS IN WHICH
TO FILE A CHAPTER 11 PLAN AND TO SOLICIT VOTES THEREON

This Matter came before the Court on the motion (the "Motion")¹ of the above captioned Debtor and Debtor in possession (collectively, the "Debtor") for entry of an order pursuant to section 1121(d) of the Bankruptcy Code extending the Exclusive Periods in which to file a Chapter 11 plan and to solicit acceptances thereof. It appears that this Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334. It appears that this proceeding is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2). It appears that venue of this proceeding and this Motion is proper in this district pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409. Due and proper notice of the Motion have been given. After due deliberation, it appears that sufficient cause exists for granting the requested relief; and that the relief requested under the Motion is in the best interests of the Debtor's estate and creditors.

IT IS ORDERED, that the Motion is granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the Debtor's Exclusive Filing Period is extended through and including February 22, 2003.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the Debtor's Exclusive Solicitation Period is extended through and including April 23, 2003.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that this Order shall be without prejudice to the Debtor's right to seek additional extensions of the Exclusive Filing Period and the Exclusive Solicitation Period.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the Court shall retain jurisdiction to hear and determine all matters arising from or relating to this Order.
