DURABLE POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT I, CARL D BIGELOW, (SS# 364-18-9677, DOB 1-1-17), the principal, of 3411 NORTH RICH ROAD, ALMA, MICHIGAN 48801, have made, constituted and appointed, SHEILA YARNELL, (SS# 363-52-6077, DOB 3-13-48), of 804 N River Avenue, Alma, MI 48821, as my attorney-in-fact This power of attorney is granted for the following purposes and provides the following powers

BANKING TRANSACTIONS

To open or close any bank, savings and loan or credit union account owned in my name alone or jointly with other(s), including my attorney, to make deposits to any such account, to sign in my name checks or drafts on such accounts, to withdraw funds from such accounts, to endorse in my name and negotiate checks, certificates of deposit, drafts and other instruments for the payment of money, and to carry on all my ordinary banking business

SECURITIES TRANSACTIONS

To sign in my name and deliver stock certificates and bonds (including stock and bond powers and assignments separate from certificate), United States Government obligations (including savings bonds, treasury bills, and bonds and notes of every type or description), and other securities, to have such securities registered in my name alone or jointly with other(s), including my attorney, to receive and receipt for all dividends and interest, to vote stock in person or by proxy, to sell and transfer any security, and to open or close or write drafts against any brokerage, money market fund, cash management or other similar account owned in my name alone or jointly with other(s), including my attorney

REAL ESTATE AND TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY

To purchase, sell or lease real estate or tangible personal property or any interest therein, to sign in my name and deliver options, purchase agreements, deeds, bills of sale, contracts and other similar or related documents, to exercise all ownership, lessor, lessee or other rights with respect to any of my real estate or tangible personal property, including the right to plat and partition real estate, and to insure and safeguard my real estate and tangible personal property

LIFE INSURANCE AND EMPLOYEE BENEFITS

To exercise any right, option or privilege available to me under any life insurance policy owned by me, including the right to surrender

the policy, obtain a policy loan, convert the policy to paid up insurance or change the beneficiary or ownership, provided that, my attorney shall not have or exercise any right, privilege or incident of ownership I hold with respect to any life insurance policy on my attorney's life. In addition, to exercise all rights, options and privileges involving retirement programs, compensation plans, pension, profit sharing and other employee fringe benefits

MOTOR VEHICLES

To apply for a certificate of title upon, and endorse in my name and transfer title to any motor vehicle, and to represent in such transfer that title to the motor vehicle is free and clear of all liens and encumbrances, except those specifically referenced

BUSINESS INTERESTS

To continue to conduct or participate in any business in which I may be engaged, and to perform or amend any business agreement to which I may be a party, to sell, exchange, modify or terminate any business, to enter into partnership agreements and amendments thereto, to incorporate, reorganize, merge, consolidate, recapitalize, sell, liquidate or dissolve any corporation or business, and to elect or employ officers, directors and agents

CONTRACTS

To enter into and perform on my behalf any contract or business transaction and in fulfillment thereof to sign in my name and deliver all necessary documents

COLLECTION POWERS

To demand, sue for, collect or forgive all indebtedness owed me, to exercise all legal and equitable remedies to collect indebtedness owed me, to adjust and compromise all indebtedness owed me, and to receipt for and discharge indebtedness owed me

INVESTMENTS

To invest in stocks, bonds (including United States Treasury Bonds which can be redeemed at par to pay federal estate taxes in my estate), securities, real estate, life insurance annuities, endowment policies or in any other investment, to deal with and give instructions to any brokerage firm with respect to the purchase, sale or other disposition of securities and other assets, to add assets to or withdraw assets from any account in my name, and to sign in my name any representation, certification or agreement, including agreements regarding margin, option trading or commodities accounts

TAX RETURNS

To sign in my name and file tax reports, returns, declarations, forms and statements for all taxes including income, gift, real estate,

personal property, intangibles and single business, to pay such taxes and any interest or penalty thereon, to file objections, protests, claims or abatement and claims for refund or credit in relation to any such tax, and to employ attorneys, accountants or other representatives, and grant powers of attorney thereof for any of the above purposes

SAFE DEPOSIT BOX

To lease a safe deposit box, to enter any safe deposit box leased by me individually or jointly, to withdraw or change the contents thereof, and to exchange or surrender the box

AGENTS

To retain, compensate and discharge agents, accountants, attorneys, real estate brokers and other professional assistance

SOCIAL SECURITY AND GOVERNMENT BENEFITS

To make application to any governmental agency for any benefit or government program to which I may be entitled, and to endorse in my name any checks or drafts made payable to me from any government agency for my benefit, including any social security and veteran's checks

BORROWINGS

To borrow money, unsecured or secured by any of my property, and for such purpose to sign in my name and deliver notes and/or renewals thereof, mortgages, pledges, guaranties and similar documents

LIVING TRUST

To transfer any of my real estate and personal property, tangible and intangible, to the trustee(s) of any revocable intervivos trust which I establish or any trust in which I have an unlimited discretionary right of withdrawal To accomplish this purpose, my attorney may sign in my name and deliver to my trustee(s) all deeds, bills of sale, assignments, stock powers, stock certificates and other documents necessary to transfer legal title to my real and personal property, specifically including disability, hospital and medical policies and the right to receive payments and profits, and may terminate bank accounts, investment advisory accounts, brokerage accounts, custody accounts and all other accounts by transferring the balance in these accounts to my trustee(s)

DEBTS AND EXPENSES

To pay bills, loans, notes or other indebtedness owed by me, or which may be incurred by my attorney for my benefit, and to incur and pay all reasonable expenses related to the control, management and supervision of my property and the maintenance, support, care and comfort of myself and those dependent upon me

LEGAL PROCEEDINGS

To commence, defend and resolve all legal and administrative proceedings pertaining to me or my property

GENERAL AUTHORITY

Subject to those limitation specified in the Prohibitions section, to do and perform all matters and things, transact all business, make, execute, acknowledge and deliver all contracts, orders, writings, assurances and instruments which may be requisite or proper to effectuate any matter pertaining to me or in which I have any interest, and generally to act for me in all matters of any nature or description affecting my business, property or personal affairs. The enumeration of specific powers in the preceding sections is not intended to, nor does it limit or restrict the general powers herein granted to my attorney

PROHIBITIONS

My attorney shall not have the power to execute a will or codicil on my behalf or to execute or amend any trust on my behalf, provided that, my attorney can enter into a custodial agreement with a bank with trust powers. My attorney is a fiduciary, possessing no general or limited power of appointments. My attorney shall not exercise my powers which I receive from my attorney in a fiduciary capacity, and my attorney shall have no authority to exercise any powers, the exercise of which would cause assets of mine to be considered as taxable in my attorney's estate for the purposes of the federal estate tax or the Michigan inheritance tax.

ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS

Section headings are for convenience only and are not part of this instrument. This instrument is executed and delivered in Michigan and shall be governed by Michigan law. Third parties may rely upon the representation of my attorney as to all matters relating to any power granted to my attorney, and no person who may act in reliance upon the representations of my attorney or the authority granted to my attorney shall incur any liability to me or my estate as a result of permitting my attorney to exercise any power. Copies of this executed power may be made and delivered by my attorney, and may be relied upon by any person to the same extent as though the copy were an original.

This durable Power of Attorney shall not be affected by my disability or incapacity, except as provided by statute, it being my intent

that this durable Power of Attorney conferred upon SHEILA YARNELL shall be exercisable and continue in full force and effect notwithstanding any later mental or physical disability or incapacity of myself, and shall be valid until I die, revoke the Power of Attorney or am judicially declared incompetent
