CESSATION OF ACCRUALS – ERISA SECTION 204(H) NOTICE A plan amendment will be adopted under which benefit accruals will cease, in accordance with ERISA Section 204(h), as of March 20, 2005, whether or not the plan is terminated on that date. This means generally that the monthly normal retirement benefit payable from the plan when you reach age 65 (which under the plan's benefit formula equals your years of credited service multiplied by a dollar benefit rate, the level of which depends on when you terminated employment – the plan's final benefit rate is \$19.00), will not increase from the level you had accrued as of the earlier of your employment termination date or March 20, 2005.
