(\$1,225,874.30) and One Hundred Eight Thousand Two Hundred Thirty and Nine Hundredths (\$108,230.09) Dollars for expenses incurred; and

**IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED** that the U.S. Trustee's comments and objections relating to the rates charged for paralegals and/or law clerks is preserved and reserved to be considered in connection with the next application for compensation.
