SUBCONTRACTOR AGREEMENT

THIS SUBCONTRACTOR AGREEMENT (this "Agreement") is made and shall be effective as of the 30 May of JANUARS. by and between OnSite Sourcing Inc. . ("ONSS"), and THICOM DOLUMENT MGM. ("TRICOM").

Background

TRICOM and ONSS desire to enter into a mutually beneficial contractual and working relationship in order to provide certain consulting and other services to TRICOM customers, all on the terms and conditions set forth herein. In consideration of the foregoing, TRICOM and ONSS, intending to be legally bound, hereby agree as follows:

- Subcontractor Relationship. ONSS acknowledges 5.
 that TRICOM, from time to time, authorizes
 subcontractors having complimentary and
 qualified skills to assist TRICOM in promoting
 and obtaining project work opportunities. ONSS
 desires to provide its professional skills and
 expertise to TRICOM and its customers, and
 TRICOM desires to engage ONSS, for such
 purpose.
- 2. ONSS Marketing Materials. ONSS may, from time to time, in the exercise of its sole discretion, elect to provide TRICOM with certain ONSS marketing literature, sales brochures, company profiles and business cards, as well as limited access to communications equipment and business plans. TRICOM agrees to utilize such materials solely for the purposes of the applicable subcontracting engagement.
- 3. ONSS Services. ONSS agrees to provide the specific services described in Exhibit Δ hereto (the "Services") in connection with the TRICOM customer service engagement referenced thereon. ONSS shall provide the Services in a professional manner, consistent with applicable industry standards. Unless specifically designated in writing as an authorized agent for TRICOM, ONSS may not, and shall have no power or authority to, enter into or negotiate any commitment, agreement or understanding with any ONSS or third party on behalf of TRICOM.
- Independent Contractor: Insurance. ONSS acknowledges that no employer-employee relationship is intended or exists hereunder or

otherwise between QNSS and TRICOM. ONSS agrees to carry and maintain in full force and effect all insurance coverage reasonably necessary and appropriate under applicable State and Federal laws, including, but not limited, to automobile liability, worker's compensation and unemployment insurance coverage. Upon request, ONSS shall provide TRICOM with a certificate of insurance evidencing its insurance coverage.

- Confidentiality. ONSS agrees that it will regard as confidential all information communicated to or received by ONSS in the course of or in connection with its provision of services hereunder, whether received from TRICOM or any customer of TRICOM. ONSS agrees to safeguard and maintain the confidentiality of all such information and that it will not, without TRICOM's prior written consent, make any oral or written disclosures, except to persons who may from time to time be designated by TRICOM as authorized to receive such information, or otherwise use any such information for any purpose other than the limited purpose contemplated by its service engagement. These restrictions shall not apply to information (1) generally known to the public or obtainable from public sources, (2) previously in the possession of ONSS, or (3) approved by TRICOM in writing for release without restriction.
- <u>Technology</u>. TRICOM agrees that it does not plan to build a document review application while it is partnered with ONSS.
- 7. Non-Solicitation. As a material condition to the performance by ONSS of its Services, during the term of this Agreement and for a period of one (1) year following the expiration or termination of this Agreement for any reason, TRICOM shall not (i) offer employment to any employee of ONSS. (ii) attempt to directly or indirectly induce or solicit any employee of ONSS to terminate his or her employment with ONSS, or (iii) offer employment to a former employee of ONSS for the twelve (12) month period immediately

following such former employee's termination of employment with ONSS. In the event of a breach by TRICOM of this Section, TRICOM shall, within ten (10) days of such breach, pay ONSS, in addition to any other fees required hereunder. damages in an amount equal to fifty percent (50%) of the total compensation paid to such employee or former employee in the last twelve (12) months of his or her employment by ONSS. Money damages may not be an adequate remedy for a breach by TRICOM of this Section and, therefore, in addition to any other logal or equitable remedies available to it. ONSS shall be entitled to obtain an injunction against such breach. The obligations set forth in this Section are independent covenants and shall survive the termination or expiration of this Agreement.

- 8. Compensation. Specific compensation terms shall be set forth in writing and attached hereto as Exhibit A. Additional attachments may be added to this Agreement as subsequent work opportunities and agreements are reached between TRICOM and ONSS from time to time. Compensation terms must be agreed to in writing in advance of each project by TRICOM and ONSS.
- 9. Disclaimer, EXCEPT AS EXPRESSLY SET FORTH HEREIN, ONSS MAKES NO WARRANTIES, EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED. INCLUDING WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY, OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, IN CONNECTION WITH THIS AGREEMENT AND THE TRANSACTIONS CONTEMPLATED HEREBY. IN NO EVENT SHALL ONSS BE LIABLE TO CLIENT FOR ANY INDIRECT. SPECIAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES OR LOST PROFITS ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THIS AGREEMENT OR THE PERFORMANCE OR BREACH HEREOF. EVEN IF ONSS HAS BEEN ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY THEREOF. ONSS'S LIABILITY HEREUNDER, IF ANY, SHALL IN NO EVENT EXCEED THE TOTAL OF THE FEES PAID TO ONSS HEREUNDER.
- Equipment. ONSS shall supply all equipment, tools, materials, supplies, employees and work space to accomplish its Services hercunder, with

- the exception of any hardware, software, materials, supplies and space to be furnished by TRICOM customers or TRICOM, to the extent described on Exhibit A.
- Supervision. ONSS retains the right and responsibility to control or direct the manner in which the Services described herein are to be octformed.
- 12. Expenses: Taxes. ONSS shall be responsible for all expenses incurred in providing its Services hereunder, including, without limitation, telephone expense, long distance charges, payroll taxes, worker's compensation and fringe benefits for employees.
- 13. Term. This Agreement shall remain in full force and effect until terminated by either party upon thirty (30) days prior written notice; provided. however, that either party may terminate this Agreement at any time in the event of a breach by the other party of any of its representations or obligations hereunder which remains uncured, if curable, for a period of ten (10) days following written notice of such breach. This Agreement, together with the Exhibits attached hereto, constitutes the entire agreement and understanding between TRICOM and ONSS with respect to the subject matter hereof. This Agreement and all rights hereunder shall inure to the benefit of the respective parties, their successors and assigns.
- 14. Assignment: Governing Law. This Agreement may not be assigned by either party without the prior written consent of the other. If any clause of this Agreement is determined to be unenforceable under applicable federal or state law, the exclusion of such clause shall not affect the validity or enforceability of this Agreement. The validity of this Agreement, the construction and enforcement of its terms, and the interpretation of the rights and duties of the parties will be governed by the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, without regard to its conflict of laws principles.

Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is made as of the 15th day of January 2008, by and between Tricom Document Management, Inc., a California based corporation ("Tricom") and ONSITE, a Virginia corporation ("Onsite").

About Onsite3

ONSITE³ is a leading global provider of forensics, discovery, review, and consulting services to law firms and corporations.

About Tricom

Tricom is a litigation support company offering domestic as well as offshore document coding, discovery and attorncy review services.

Scope of MOU

Tricom has shown interest in using ONSITE's online document review tool cVicw. Tricom would like to use this tool as part of their Attorney Review service offering. ONSITE's is interested in promoting its review tool through partnership with Tricom. ONSITE's may also offer Tricom's attorney review services to its clients.

Additionally, ONSITE³ has retained Tricom to provide document coding services on numerous projects. This relationship between ONSITE³ and Tricom has proven to be mutually beneficial to both corporations and their clients and the parties wish to strengthen this coding relationship so as to hencefit the parties and their clients.

Terms of MOU

This Pricing Guideline and the information contained herein is the proprietary and confidential information of ONSITE³. The information from the guideline, whether written or implied, is not to be used, discussed or copied for any other purpose except with prior expressed written consent of ONSITE³.

- 6. Onsite's will allow Tricom continuing access to eView and the eView demo database for training and promotion purposes.
- 7. Pricing schedules of ONSITE³ & Tricom are attached with this MOU. The schedule reflects ONSITE³'s pricing to Tricom for cView, discovery, and hosting services. Tricom's pricing schedule reflects rates for Attorney Review Services to ONSITE³.
- 8. Both Onsite3 and Tricom understand that there is no exclusivity in this relationship except as described below in regard to outsourced coding work. As to document review services/review applications Tricom will promote eView to its client, and ONSITE3 will promote Tricom's attorney review services; however, the final decision would be with the end client.
- 9. To further enhance the coding relationship between the parties and obtain the best pricing and service for ONSITE³ and it's clients the parties also agree as follows regarding coding services:
 - a. Tricom will provide sales support to ONSITE? including sales training, joint sales conferences and calls, technical support, and other reasonable sales support as necessary to ensure continued success.
 - b. Tricom will provide a dedicated domestic Project Manager who shall be responsible for ONSITE's projects. This Project Manager will manage and coordinate production requirements for both domestic and offshore projects.
 - c. Tricom has developed an online Project Tracking tool and will provide access to ONSITE² promoting real time, on demand, project status.
 - d. Tricom will provide ONSITE³ with the highest level of production priority with planning and allocating production resources across ongoing projects.
 - e. Tricom will provide ONSITE¹ a comprehensive, standardized price guide with the company's most aggressive pricing as described in Appendix B attached hereto.
 - 1. Tricom will provide ONSITE' a volume bonus discount based on attaining annual levels of business as described in Appendix C attached hereto.
 - g. During the term of this agreement Tricom will not develop any document review applications or document review software, and will not use any ONSITE's proprietary information in any later development operations.
 - h. Except to the extent Tricom: 1) cannot meet a client's turnaround time, 2) doesn't have the capacity required for a job, or 3) turns down a job, ONSITE' will not engage other coding vendors for outsourced coding work in during the term of this Agreement. ONSITE' will continue to offer in-house coding services to its clients.
 - i. The parties grant each the right to reference the parties' strategic alliance and relationship in any or all marketing efforts including but not limited to the websites, press releases, and in providing references to prospective clients. Each party shall have the right to review and recommend changes regarding such marketing efforts.

- 10. OnSite will host all TRICOM data within OnSite's current cVicw hosting infrastructure.
- 11. OnSite will bill TRICOM directly for all services; refer to <u>Attachment A</u> for TRICOM/OnSite Pricing Guideline details.
- 12. Pricing may be negotiated beyond the terms of the agreement depending on scope of project and must be approved by OnSite and TRICOM.
- 13. TRICOM will serve as project management for all cases on eView, TRICOM will utilize eView for case management and support and technical questions about the tool.
- 14. On Site will not contact TRICOM's client unless we have explicit permission from TRICOM and/or their client requests to speak with a technician from the eView support team.
- 15. TRICOM and OnSite will work together as best described in <u>Attachment B</u>, TRICOM and OnSite Partnership Workflow Specifications details.
- 16. On Site will work closely with and provide TRICOM the details spees for processing the data in order to assure all functions work properly once data is loaded to eView.
