**MOTION TO ESTABLISH CLAIMS BAR DATE FOR FILING CLAIMS RELATING  
TO REJECTION OF AN EXECUTORY CONTRACT OR UNEXPIRED LEASE**

1. On May 6, 2013, the Debtors filed voluntary petitions for relief under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code.

2. By this Motion, the Debtors seek entry of an order establishing the bar date for claims relating to rejection of an executory contract or unexpired lease as the later of (i) thirty days from the date of rejection or (ii) thirty days from the date of this Order.

**ORDER ESTABLISHING BAR DATE FOR FILING CLAIMS RELATING TO  
REJECTION OF AN EXECUTORY CONTRACT OR UNEXPIRED LEASE**

The matter is before the Court on the Motion of the Debtors to establish the last date for filing claims relating to rejection of an executory contract or unexpired lease. It appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that just cause exists to grant the Motion without further notice or hearing, it is

ORDERED as follows:

1. The last date to assert a claim relating to rejection of an executory contract or unexpired lease shall be the later of (i) thirty days from the date of rejection or (ii) thirty days from the date of this Order.
2. Upon the entry of this Order, a copy of this Order shall be served by U.S. first class mail to all creditors on the court matrix in all of the jointly administered cases and persons who have filed notices of appearance in accordance with Rule 2002(i) of the Bankruptcy Rules.
3. Any creditor who has previously filed a proof of claim relating to rejection of an executory contract or unexpired lease is not required to refile its claim.
