**EXPEDITED MOTION TO CONTINUE STATUS CONFERENCE REGARDING

1. Relief Requested. The Debtors request the Court continue the status conference on the Debtors' Motion for Substantive Consolidation (the "Motion") scheduled for October 2, 2013 at 1:30 p.m.

2. Need for Expedited Order. The Debtors and the Committee are in discussion with the objecting parties in order to work out an agreement regarding their objections.
