The undersigned further certifies that they have caused the Court’s docket in this case to be reviewed and that no answer, objection or other responsive pleading to the Monthly Statements appears thereon. Procedures for Interim Compensation and Reimbursement Expenses for Professionals (the “Interim Procedures Order”) entered on June 24, 2004, objections to a monthly fee statement filed by a specifically retained professional were to be filed and served twenty (20) days after the filing and service of the respective monthly fee statement.
