**ORDER AUTHORIZING THE DEBTORS AND
DEBTORS-IN-POSSESSION TO EMPLOY AND RETAIN
ARNOLD & PORTER LLP AS SPECIAL LITIGATION
COUNSEL PURSUANT TO 11 U.S.C. §§ 327(e) AND 328(a)**

Upon the application (the “Application”) of Pegasus Satellite Television, Inc. and certain of its subsidiaries and affiliates, each a debtor and debtor-in-possession herein (collectively, the “Debtors”),¹ for an order authorizing the Debtors and Debtors-in-Possession to employ and retain Arnold & Porter LLP (“Arnold & Porter”) as special litigation counsel pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 327(e) and 328(a); and upon the Affidavit of Ted S. Lodge, President, Chief Operating Officer and Counsel of Pegasus Satellite Communications, Inc., in support of First Day Motions; and upon the Affidavit of David Eisen in Support of Application for Order Authorizing the Debtors and Debtor-in-Possession to Employ and Retain Arnold & Porter LLP as Special Litigation Counsel

pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 327(e) and 328(a), and Disclosure of Compensation Pursuant to Bankruptcy Code 11 U.S.C. § 329; and notice of the Application having been given to (i) the United States Trustee for the District of Maine; (ii) the Debtors' fifty (50) largest unsecured creditors on a consolidated basis, as identified in their chapter 11 petitions; (iii) the administrative agents for the credit facilities of Pegasus Media & Communications, Inc. and Pegasus Satellite Communications, Inc. ("PSC"); (iv) each of the indenture trustees for each series of notes of PSC and (v) those parties in interest who have filed a notice of appearance; and it appearing that no other notice need be given; and it appearing that Arnold & Porter neither holds nor represents any interest adverse to the Debtors' estates; and it appearing that Arnold & Porter is "disinterested," as that term is defined in section 101(14) of the Bankruptcy Code; and it appearing that the relief requested in the Application is in the best interest of the estate and its creditors; after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor, it is hereby

ORDERED, that the Application be, and it hereby is granted; and it is further

ORDERED, that in accordance with sections 327(e) and 328(a) of the Bankruptcy Code, the Debtors are authorized to employ and retain the firm of Arnold & Porter as their special litigation counsel on the terms set forth in the Application; and it is further

ORDERED, that Arnold & Porter shall be compensated in accordance with the procedures set forth in sections 330 and 331 of the Bankruptcy Code and such Bankruptcy Rules as may then be applicable, from time to time, and such procedures as may be fixed by order of this Court.
