**ORDER REFERRING CLAIM FOR ARBITRATION ON DEBTORS' SECOND OMNIBUS
OBJECTION AND MOTION TO RECLASSIFY, REDUCE OR DISALLOW CLAIM OF
DAVID R. MILLER (CLAIM NUMBER 512)**

Upon consideration of the Debtors' Second Omnibus Objection to and Motion to Reclassify, Reduce or Disallow Certain Claims Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 502(b), Bankruptcy Rule 3001 and 3007, and D. Me. LBR 3007-1 (the "Objection"),¹ pursuant to which the Debtors requested the entry of an order (the "Order") reclassifying, reducing or disallowing certain claims including that of David R. Miller, claim number 512 ("Claimant"), and after consideration of the statements of counsel made at the hearing thereon; and the Court finding that: (a) this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2), (b) notice of the Objection was due and proper under the circumstances, (c) Claimant has timely responded to the Objection, and (d) the Debtor, Golden Sky Systems, Inc. and the Claimant have agreed to refer this matter to binding arbitration under the auspices of America Arbitration Association; and good and sufficient cause appearing therefore, and the parties having consented to entry of this order; it is hereby:

ORDERED, that the liquidation of the amount of Claimant's claim is hereby referred to arbitration in Maine under the Rules of the American Arbitration Association, and it is further

ORDERED, that this Court reserves jurisdiction to (a) resolve any issue concerning implementation of his order, and (b) determine the treatment of such claim once adjudicated, including all orders regarding classification, priority and payment of said claim; and

ORDERED, that the Debtor and Claimant proceed forthwith to adjudicate the amount of the claim in accordance with this order.
