ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXPEDITED HEARING

Upon the motion (the “Motion”) of Pegasus Satellite Television, Inc. and certain of its subsidiaries and affiliates, each a debtor and debtor-in-possession herein (collectively, the “Debtors”),¹ requesting entry of an order pursuant to Rule 9013-1(i) of the District of Maine Local Bankruptcy Rules granting an expedited hearing on the Debtors’ motion for entry of an order pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 105, 363(b) and 365 and Bankruptcy Rule 9019 authorizing and approving (i) the First Amendment to the Master Site Agreement and the Replacement Site Agreements with Spectrasite Broadcast Towers, Inc. (“Spectrasite”); (ii) the Debtors’ assumption of the Master Site Agreement, as amended by the First Amendment; (iii) the Debtors’ settlement of Spectrasite’s damage claim; and (iv) granting related relief (the “Spectrasite Motion”); and it appearing that the Court has jurisdiction to consider the Motion and the relief requested therein in accordance with 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; and it appearing that this matter is a core

ORDERED, that the Motion is granted; and it is further

ORDERED, that an expedited hearing on the Spectrasite Motion will be held on April 6, 2005 at 1:00 p.m. (prevailing Eastern time); and it is further

ORDERED, that any objections or responses to the Spectrasite Motion must be filed by April 6, 2005 at 10:00 a.m. (prevailing Eastern time).
