**ORDER GRANTING EXPEDITED HEARING
AND SHORTENING OBJECTION PERIOD TO MOTION UNDER BANKRUPTCY
RULE 3018**

This matter came before the Court on the Motion of the Ad Hoc Noteholders Committee of Pegasus Satellite Communications, Inc. (the “Ad Hoc Noteholders Committee”) for Expedited Hearing and for Shortened Objection Period, and after such hearing and notice as is required by Title 11 of the United States Code, the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure and the Local Rules of this Court, the Court finding just cause for the relief sought by the Motion for Expedited Hearing, it is hereby ORDERED:

That the Motion for Expedited Hearing is granted. An expedited hearing on the Ad Hoc Noteholders Committee’s Motion for Entry of an Order Pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 3018(a) Allowing Change of Previously Cast Votes Relating to the First Amended Joint Chapter 11 Plan of Pegasus Satellite Television, Inc. and its subsidiaries and certain of its affiliates (the “3018 Motion”), is set for April 14, 2005, at 10:30 a.m. EDT. Objections must be filed with the clerk of court and served on John P. McVeigh at One City Center, P.O. Box 9546, Portland, Maine 04112-9546, on or before April 13, 2005 at 4:00 p.m. EDT.
