**ORDER GRANTING THE REORGANIZED DEBTORS AND THE  
LIQUIDATING TRUSTEE'S FIFTH OMNIBUS  
OBJECTION AND MOTION TO RECLASSIFY, REDUCE  
OR DISALLOW CERTAIN CLAIMS PURSUANT TO 11 U.S.C. §502(E)(1)(B),  
BANKRUPTCY RULE 3007, AND D. ME. LBR 3007-1**

Upon consideration of the Reorganized Debtors and the Liquidating Trustee's Fifth Omnibus Objection and Motion to Reclassify, Reduce or Disallow Certain claims Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 502(e)(1)(B), Bankruptcy Rule 3007, and D. Me. LBR 3007-1 (the "Fifth Objection"),<sup>1</sup> pursuant to which the Reorganized Debtors and the Liquidating Trustee requested the entry of an order reclassifying, reducing or disallowing the claims listed in Exhibit A to the Fifth Objection; and upon consideration of the Fifth Objection and all pleadings related thereto, including the statements of counsel made at the hearing thereon; and the Court finding that (a) the Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334, (b) this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2), and (c) notice of the Fifth Objection was due and proper under the circumstances; and it appearing that the relief requested in the Fifth Objection is in the best interests of the Reorganized Debtors, their estates and creditors; and good and sufficient cause appearing therefore; it is hereby

ORDERED, that the relief requested in the Fifth Objection is granted; and it is further

ORDERED, that each of the Contingent Indemnification Claims listed on Exhibit A to the Fifth Objection is hereby disallowed and expunged in its entirety; and it is further

ORDERED, that the Reorganized Debtors, the Liquidating Trustee, and the Clerk of this Court are authorized to take all actions necessary or appropriate to give effect to this Order; and it is further

ORDERED, that this Court shall retain jurisdiction to hear and determine all matters arising from and related to the implementation of this Order.
