**ORDER GRANTING EXPEDITED HEARING
AND SHORTENING OBJECTION PERIOD**

This matter came before the Court on the Motion of the Reorganized Debtors and the Liquidating Trustee for Expedited Hearing and For Shortened Objection Period, and after such hearing and notice as is required by Title 11 of the United States Code, the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure and the Local Rules of this Court, the Court finding just cause for the relief sought by the Motion for Expedited Hearing, it is hereby ORDERED:

That the Motion for Expedited Hearing is granted. An expedited hearing on the Motion of the Reorganized Debtors and the Liquidating Trustee for an Order (i) Authorizing the Assumption of Certain Executory Contracts Between Pegasus Broadcast Television, Inc. and Fox Broadcasting Company and/or Fox News Network, L.L.C. and (ii) Granting Such Other Relief As Is Just and Proper (the "Assumption Motion"), is set for June 10, 2005, at 10:30 a.m. EDT.
