**ORDER GRANTING TRAVIS COUNTY'S APPLICATION FOR PAYMENT OF
ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES**

THIS MATTER CAME ON for consideration the Application of Nelda Wells Spears, Travis County Tax Collector, praying for the payment of the post petition ad valorem taxes incurred by Pegasus Satellite Television, Inc., during the pending bankruptcy case, and it appearing that notice is proper and that no response was timely filed pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 9014, **IT IS THEREFORE,**

ORDERED that Travis County's Application for Payment of Administrative Expense (2005) in the amount of \$730.30, for the tax year 2005, against Debtors Pegasus Satellite Television, Inc., be allowed as filed.

IT IS FURTHER, ORDERED that the Debtors will remit the ad valorem property tax for the tax year 2005, in the amount of **\$730.30**, along with all statutory interest and penalties accrued at such time of payment, with said remittance to be sent in care of Karon Y. Wright, Assistant County Attorney, Bankruptcy Section, P.O. Box 1748, Austin, Texas 78767, within ten (10) days from the entry of the Court's Order.
