**ORDER GRANTING MOTION ON SHORT NOTICE FOR AN ORDER
IN AID OF CONSUMMATION OF THE PLAN**

Upon consideration of the Motion of Pegasus Satellite Television, Inc. and certain of its subsidiaries and affiliates, each a Reorganized Debtor herein, and the Liquidating Trustee of The PSC Liquidating Trust (the “Motion”) for an Order In Aid of Consummation of the Plan pursuant to which the Reorganized Debtors¹ and the Liquidating Trustee requested the entry of an order authorizing PSC and/or the Trust to freely sell the PCC Shares without complying with the registration requirements of the Securities Act of 1933, and the Court having considered all pleadings and arguments of counsel relating thereto, and the Court finding that (a) the Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334, the Plan and the Confirmation Order (b) this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2), (c) notice of the Motion was due and proper under the circumstances; and it appearing that the relief requested in the Motion is in the best interests of the Reorganized Debtors, their estates and creditors, and good and sufficient cause appearing therefore; it is hereby

ORDERED, that the Motion is granted; and it is further

ORDERED, that either PSC and/or the Trust may freely sell the PCC Shares without complying with the registration requirements of § 5 of the Securities Action of 1933; and it is further

ORDERED, that the Reorganized Debtors, the Liquidating Trustee, and the Clerk of this Court are authorized to take all actions necessary or appropriate to give effect to this Order; and it is further

ORDERED, that this Court shall retain jurisdiction to hear and determine all matters arising from and related to the implementation of this Order.
