DECLARATION OF PAUL KASSAB

I, PAUL KASSAB, based upon my personal knowledge and under penalty of perjury, do declare and state the following:

1. I currently live at 923 NW Woodlands Terrace, Lake City, Florida, 32055.
2. I receive DIRECTV satellite television service from Pegasus Satellite Television, Inc. I have had an account with Pegasus since approximately November 2003.
3. During the week of June 7, 2004, while watching television on various channels, I have seen a message appear at the bottom of the screen. The message said that important news was on channel 205.
4. Upon seeing this message, I have turned to channel 205 on more than one occasion. Channel 205 displayed a message about Pegasus's services and said to "stay tuned."
5. On June 12, 2004, I was watching television and again saw a message flash at the bottom of the screen. The message said, "See channel 205 for important news!"

6. I turned to channel 205 and saw a new message about DIRECTV ending its relationship with Pegasus. The message included a phone number to call.

7. I called DIRECTV at the number included in the message on channel 205, which was 866-235-2500 to inquire about that message. I was connected to a female customer service representative for DIRECTV. I inquired about the message on the screen and she told me that I was going to have the opportunity to convert my service to DIRECTV and that she would send out a letter to me that would explain.

8. On June 13, 2004 I called the 866-235-2500 number again as I wanted to clarify some of the information that I had previously been told.

9. I was connected to a male customer service representative for DIRECTV named David. I told David that I had seen the message on channel 205 and that I had called to inquire about it yesterday, but I was not sure I had understood what was going on with Pegasus or the information that was provided to me the day before so I was calling back to clarify what I had been told.

10. I asked David what was on going on with Pegasus. David told me "Pegasus was going out of business."

11. David then asked me my name, address, zip code and telephone number and then told me to hold on a moment because he was "getting me up on his screen."

12. I asked him what information he had on his screen and he told me again, that I needed to hold on because he was still pulling me up on his screen.

13. After a moment he then told me that he could he see my address, city, zip code, telephone number and the services provided by Pegasus. He also told me that he knew that I rented my receivers from Pegasus.

14. David said I should expect to receive a letter in the mail sometime next week. I asked him what the letter was about. He said I just needed to fill out the letter and return it and it would stop service with Pegasus and ok DIRECTV to provide service to me.

15. I asked if there was anything else I should know. David said no there was not, just that I would be getting the letter next week and that I should fill it out and send it back to them.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct. Executed on the 14th day of June, 2004.
